Course Title: Civil Law

Course Credits: 9

Language of Instruction: Albanian

Course Description: The subject begins with the meaning of the right in general and then focuses on the treatment of the part of general of the Civil Code by analyzing civil law institutes such as natural persons, persons legal and their types. A detailed analysis is made of the institutes of representation, legal actions, prescription, ownership and inheritance. This analysis is provided through a detailed interpretation of the content of the provisions to the Civil Code.

Course Goals: This course aims to familiarize students with the basic structure and content of law civil. In this course, the basic principles of civil law and its basic institutes will be dealt with. The meaning of the legal norms contained in the Civil Code is also given under the perspective of Albanian judicial practice in the new social conditions of the development of society Albanian considering also realities unforeseen by the legislator at the time of drafting Civil Code.

Course Requirements: The student's obligations consist of: completing written and/or oral tests, preparing course assignment in the group, and in active participation in seminars. Failure to attend at least 25% of seminars means the students cannot enter the final exam.

Grading: The final assessment will be 100 points which will be divided into:

20 points group coursework,

20 points participation and activation in seminars,

60 points of the final exam

Course Schedule: The course includes 60 hours of lectures and 30 hours of seminars. Lectures will be delivered weekly. The schedule of activities is subject to change.
