Course Title: Labor Law

Course Credits: 7

Language of Instruction: Albanian

Course Description: Introduction to the basic concepts related to labor law, particularly with labor standards and labor relations. The students will have an opportunity to understand the written labor law, discuss domestic and international standards, and solve hypotheticals. The course will be delivered through the classical method of classroom lectures and seminars, but interactive methods will be integrated in them to make this course more accessible, to the students.

Course Goals: To familiarize students with the nature, source, function, effects and applications of labor law. To introduce the concept of labor standards, labor relations, and social legislation.

Course Requirements: Failure to attend at least 25% of seminars means the students cannot enter the final exam. The exam might be taken in the fall semester.

The student is required to take active participation in seminars and present a paper based on specific guidance.

Grading: The final grade will be determined based on a maximum score of 100 points. These will be collected in the following way:

- Maximum 10 points for a paper;
- Maximum 30 points for contributions to seminars;
- Maximum 60 points for a final written exam.

Course Schedule: The course includes 60 hours of lectures and 15 hours of seminars. Lectures will be delivered bi-weekly. The schedule of activities is subject to change.
