**Language of Instruction: Albanian Language** 

**Course Description:** 

The course aims to:

- make the student acquire full knowledge and comprehension of the fundamental rules and

institutions of private law (persons, the rights of personality, the rights of ownership, property

interests, real estates, the law of obligations, the law of contracts, tort law) so as to enable him to

approach the subsequent courses, meaning in particular International Trade Law, Commercial Law

and Private International Law;

- make the student acquire full knowledge of the structure of Albanian Civil Code as the

fundamental tool for managing any private law issue, both within the degree course and the future

career dealing with private law issues and the comparison with other civil codes, such as Italian

Civil Code.

**Course Goals:** 

- full knowledge and comprehension of the main private law institutions;

- ability to fully understand and critically argue the opinion in relation to topical problems linked

with private law;

- ability to solve a private law case dealing with the principles and the rules within the Albanian

Civil Code.

Course Requirements: Students who make 50% of absences during seminars cannot take part in

the exam of the regular season. Students are evaluated with points during the year for their

activation in seminars as part of continuous assessment

**Grading**: Continuous assessment 30%

Final exam 70%

Passing marks start from 45 points and above.

**Course Schedule**: This course includes 60 hours of lectures and 15 hours of seminars. Lectures will be held four times a week, while seminars once a week.
