**Course Description:** The subject civil law (special part), consists as the part of the law of obligations and is part of the grouping of characteristic subjects, preparation for the scientific discipline, symbol B. The special civil law represents the set of legal norms regulating the relations of obligations between the parties. The relationship of obligations includes those legal relationships where one entity, which is called a creditor, has the right to demand from the other entity, which is called a debtor, the repayment of the contractual obligation.

**Course Goals:** After completing this course, students will be able to learn about the rights and obligations of debtors and creditors, the types of contracts in civil circulation, to draft and compile different types of contracts

**Course Requirements:** Students who make 50% of absences during seminars cannot take part in the exam of the regular season. Students are evaluated with points during the year for their activation in seminars as part of continuous assessment.
