Course Title: Creative Writing

Course Credits: 4 ECTS

Language of Instruction: English

Course Description: A course in Creative Writing helps students to commit themselves to writing projects, communicate effectively with chosen readers, and question their own certainties. They will understand that knowledge of writing comes both from analyzing writing and from working hard on their own writing. We attempt to assist students focus on what is important yet offer multiple options for critical reading as well as writing. The result of this reimagining is what you hold in your hands: a text that we believe to be flexible, engaging, and pedagogically effective.

Course Goals: Students will be able to: Read as writers, developing their critical faculties and their confidence so that they can analyze their own writing as well as that of others; identify and use a range of writing craft techniques; structure their work through a variety of different voices and forms.
