Course Title: Italian language for specific purposes (Sectorial language)

Course Credits: 5

Language of Instruction: Italian

Course Description: This course aims to provide students with the basic knowledge about Italian for specific purposes, Italian for professional communication, business, tourism. Among other things, it is a discipline that best interweaves linguistic knowledge with professional knowledge. The student will face daily situations of oral or written professional communication. Students will know and understand cultural, social and administrative realities of the Italian world of business, tourism, hotel industry, gastronomy and beyond.

Course Goals:

This course will allow the student

- to approach the linguistic and cultural aspects of professional life in field of tourism and business through communication situations;
- to acquire a specific vocabulary for the field of Italian on specific objectives;
- to enrich and improve professional communicative skills through the presentation of numerous written and oral documents;
- react correctly in Italian, in writing and orally, in different situations;
- to master written and oral translation techniques in foreign languages for specific purposes;
- develop strategies for working independently or in groups to carry out concrete tasks through various activities.
