Course Title: Didactic of Italian Literature

Course Credits: 5

Language of Instruction: Italian

Course Description: The course consist in a short theoretical part to the presentation of point for riflection relating to the student as a subject of literary education and a practical part, called the didactic laboratory. It's dedicated to the procedure from theory to practice, to the analysis of possible structuring of teaching materials for introducing literature, to the use of literary texts for intercultural education and for the development of skills relational.

Course Goals: The student must be able to prepare a didactic unit of Italian literature in the service of learning the Italian language and culture, be able to refresh and enrich the classical teaching of literature, including new concepts, be able to select the material of used for the design of the didactic unit, adhering to the basic didactic data of teaching literature, operatic works and singing.

Course Requirements: Attendance and engagement during the course, participation in discussions and the unfolding of imagination for the enrichment of the range of arguments beyond the traditional ones, practical work in the design of didactic units, of didactic activities, course assignments.

Grading: 1,5 ects of the final grade from the course assignment, 3,5 ects the final oral exam.

Course Schedule: A total of 45 hours of teoretichal and practical work in auditorium and 80 hours of individual student work.
