Course Title: Ethics in foreign language teaching

Course Credits: 5

Language of Instruction: Albanian

Course Description:

The course provides theoretical knowledge on concepts such as ethics, morality, conscience, moral values, professional ethics and issues such as ethics and foreign language teaching, role of ethics in the formation of foreign language teachers, ethical education of foreign language teachers and students, problems of confronting different cultures, teacher strategies for avoiding problems.

During the seminars, the aforementioned concepts are elaborated during discussions, exercises and practical tasks.

Course Goals:

The course aims to help students, future teachers, to become familiar with the main problems of teaching ethics, its functions in the didactics of foreign languages as well as the ethical dimensions of the professional behavior of the foreign language teacher. Activities, various exercises and case studies aim to develop in students the ability to apply the basic principles of the teacher's professional ethics.

Course Requirements:

- Attendance (the course has to be attended in 60% for the lecture classes and 75% for the seminar classes),
- Active Participation,
- Mid-term exams,
- Final exam.

Grading:

A final course grade will be the sum total of the points allocated to each completed requirement.

30 % is the active participation during the semester and 70 % the final exam.

Course Schedule:

The course is scheduled in one semester, 1 fifty-minute lecture classes and 2 fifty-minute seminar classes per week.
