Course Title: Abnormal psychology

Course Credits: 9

Language of Instruction: Albanian

Course Description: "Abnormal Psychology" subject takes place in the study program "Bachelor in Psychology", Course II.

Course Goals: Through this course, students of this study program receive deep concepts and knowledges about abnormal behavior, about major disorders, their causes, their factors, their symptoms, and the main ways of treating them. It is intended to be present a rich theoretical material taken from the sources of contemporary psychological literature, and it has also been intended to be present illustrations with examples of clinical cases from literature.

Course Requirements: The final assessment will be reflected in the amount of points that students have accumulated based on the following:

- Active participation in the seminars hours - 20 points (maximum).
- Intermediate exams -10 points (maximum). There will be two intermediate exams (5 points for each intermediate exam).
- Course assignment - 10 points (maximum).
- Final written exam - 60 points (maximum).
- Examination of additional materials found by the student himself in the form of bonus -5 point (maximum).

Grading: Grade 10 (96-100 points); Grade 9 (86-95 points); Grade 8 (76-85 points); Grade 7 (66-75 points); Grade 6 (56-65 points); Grade 5 (45-55 points); Grade 4 (less than 45 points).

Course Schedule: This course takes place in the first and second semester, with weekly academic workload 2/1 (two hours lections, one hour seminar). Lecture attendane is not mandatory. Seminar attendance is mandatory in 75% of hours.
