Course Title: Cultural Anthropology

Course Credits: 6

Language of Instruction: Albanian

Course Description: The subject "*Cultural Anthropology*" deals with a cycle of topics and lectures about culture and the importance of cultural heritage values. The main objective of the subject is the preparation and the qualification of the students to understand, describe and analyze the anthropology in general, but especially The Cultural Anthropology. Moreover, at the same time to create a clear framework about the importance and its features as a social and human science.

Course Goals: General knowledge about culture and Cultural Anthropology, the main problems of history as a discipline, the main developments of culture and anthropology and extended knowledge about the concept and the role of anthropology.

Course Requirements: The student is required to attend the lectures and seminars as well as to consult the suggested literature. They are also required to follow systematically annual and semestral projects and engagements as an integral part of the educational process. Moreover, the exam participation and subject obligation are required to obtain possible subject credits.

Grading: The method of assessment is semestral and is carried out through traditional and alternative forms of assessment that reflect an assessment as an integral part of the learning process. Evaluative elements of the subject are the mid-terms, course assignments and the final exam. All these elements together determine the final evaluation.
