Language of Instruction: Albanian.

Course Description: "Advanced Methods of Scientific Research" is a basic subject of the Master of Science study program in "Clinical Psychology".

For the best acquisition of this subject, the student must have knowledge acquired during bachelor's studies in the basic subjects of methodological preparation and general culture.

Course Goals: The objective of the course is to provide students with advanced knowledge of social science methodology and to enable them to conduct empirical research respecting scientific principles.

Course Requirements: The final assessment will be reflected in the amount of points that students have accumulated, based on the following:

- Active participation in the seminars hours 20 points (maximum).
- -Course assignment 10 points (maximum).
- -Final written exam 70 points (maximum).

Grading: Grade 10 (96-100 points); Grade 9 (86-95 points); Grade 8 (76-85 points); Grade 7 (66-75 points); Grade 6 (56-65 points); Grade 5 (45-55 points); Grade 4 (less than 45 points).

Course Schedule: This course takes place in the second semester, with weekly academic workload 4/2 (four hours lectures, two hours seminars). Attendance in lectures is facultative. Seminars attendance is mandatory not less than 75% of hours.
