## Language of Instruction: Albanian

Course Description: The study of English in the first cycle of studies, the first year, aims to acquire linguistic and cultural knowledge. Through diverse topics, the student has the opportunity to gain new knowledge and also to put it into practice. The object of study of this subject is based on today's demand of the labor market for professionals with interdisciplinary knowledge, not only profiled in one field. The teaching material offers the opportunity to use student-centered approaches supporting their language and communication needs.

Course Goals: This material promotes the participation of students in learning and emphasizes the primary role of students in the acquisition of a foreign language, with the basic purpose of its practical use both for general purposes and for specific purposes related to the professional requirements of students and future specialists. For the efficient acquisition of this subject, the student must have a good command of the basic knowledge of the English language. Good grammatical and structural knowledge, rich vocabulary and correct pronunciation enable the student to use the English language as efficiently as possible. Tenses, Active voice, passive voice, aspect, wordformation, cleft sentences, reported speech are some of the main concepts.
