## **Course Description:**

Through the lectures held and the special literature that will be presented in this course, for students, it is intended to form clear ideas about the content of this ancient discipline as much as philosophy itself, with the object and tasks that must be solve philology in the field of human knowledge. In addition, it is envisaged that at the end of the course of lectures, students will be able to understand the textual units with which the science of philology operates and how it has become an extraordinary basis for the transmission of social thought from one generation to another.

## **Course Goals:**

Philology is the scientific discipline that has as its main objective, to verify whether a text has been transmitted in the form that the author designed in his time or not. Therefore, in the narrowest practical perspective, philology is defined as the science of the authenticity of written texts.

Philology is the study of language in written historical sources; it is a combination of literary criticism with history and linguistics.

Usually, this can be defined as the study of literary texts and written records, the study of their originality as form, and the determination of their original meaning.
